		• Provided an overview of our By-Laws as it related to Board members in "Good Standing" and what was required for a quorum to conduct DESC Business. She requested that the Board consider adopting language in the By-Laws that would better define "Good Standing" and what constitutes a quorum.

		After Committee discussion, it was recommended that the Committee make proposed language updates to the existing DESC By-Law Section 4.4:	
		<ul> <li>Proposed language: For purposes of this Section 4.4, a Director is in "Good Standing" when the Director: (a) has submitted the Director's annual written consent to abide by the corporation's Code of Conduct policy regarding conflicts of interest, as provided in Section 4.10 and/or; (b) has not exceeded two consecutive unexcused absences at Regular Meetings of the Board (an unexcused absence occurs when a Director fails to inform the meeting convener that the Director will not be attending a scheduled meeting in advance of the meeting); and/or (c) has not exceeded four excused or unexcused consecutive meeting absences If a Director has been deemed not to be in "Good Standing", a Director must sign a letter of recommitment, and attend two consecutive meetings to regain "Good Standing" status.</li> <li>Alice Thompson, Board Chair, requested a motion to update the By-Laws with the attached language:</li> </ul>
