III.	Co-Chairs Report	Co-Chair Dr. Hudson opened the report with a look at the Resident Employment noting employment decreased 0.7% in April, with 1,744 fewer Detroiters employed than in March. At 233,621, employment is above the 2023 average (233,244) and up 8,800 compared to April 2022.

departing co-chair Dave Meador.

education, unions and business leaders, policy changes and legislation, education
